## ICT ADVISORY No. 2002-01

**To:** All government agencies who are into bidding of ICT resources and all suppliers or vendors of ICT products and services

**Subject:** Accreditation or Registration of IT Solutions Providers or ICT Suppliers or Vendors

Background: The National Computer Center issued **Memorandum Circular 99-02** entitled "Prescribing Guidelines for IT Resource Acquisition in Government" in November 29, 1999 and **IT Advisory 2000-03** on the "Issuance of Certificate of Registration" in November 28, 2000 in support of MO 237 (1989), AO 332 (1997) and National Budget Circular No. 463 (1999).

1. Executive Order No. 40 (Sec. 16 and Sec. 17) and its Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) require the Bids and Awards Committee (BAC) of the bidding agency to determine the eligibility of prospective bidders for the procurement of all goods, supplies, materials and related services. **Hence, NCC shall no longer issue Certificates of Registration/Accreditation.**
2. All BACs of national government agencies, government-owned or controlled corporations (GOCC) and government financial institutions (GFI) including State Universities and Colleges (SUC) who are into bidding activities are required to issue a certification of official **registration in lieu of the NCC accreditation/registration.** BACs of Local Government Units (LGU) are encouraged to conduct their own eligibility check and consequently certify eligible bidders.
3. All suppliers or vendors of ICT products and services who would like to participate in government bidding of ICT resources are advised to submit pertinent documents for eligibility check to the Bids and Awards Committee (BAC) of the government agency concerned.
4. Section 36 of the IRR further prescribes the details on the procurement of ICT projects.
5. This advisory is being issued while NCC Memorandum Circular No. 99-02 is being revised to conform with EO 40.
